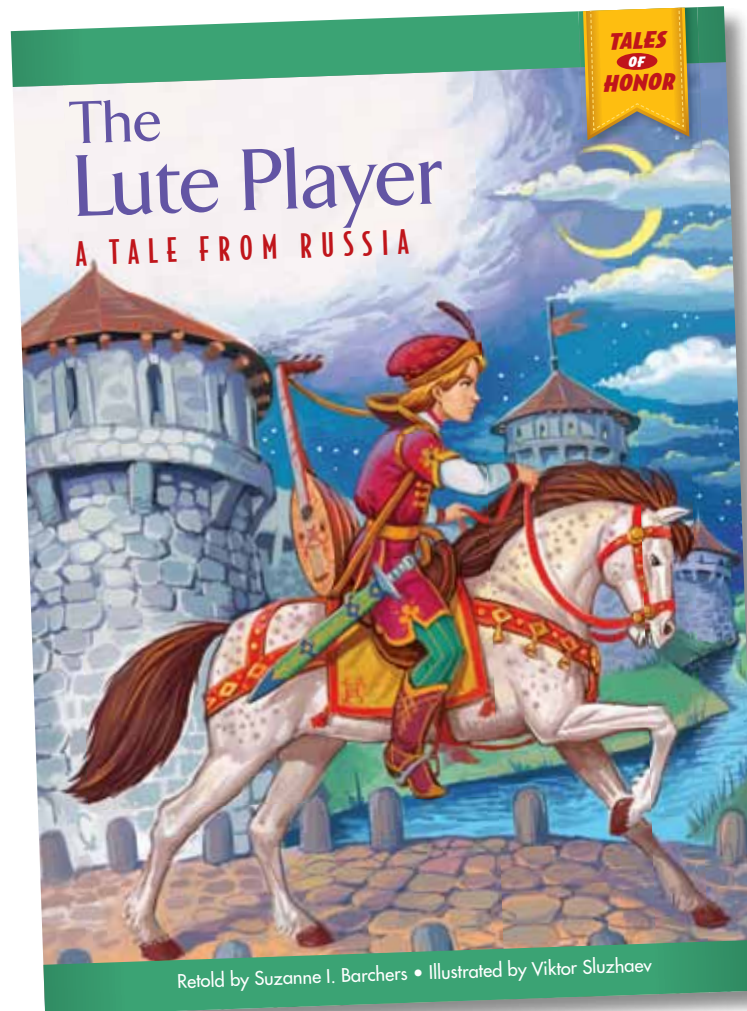
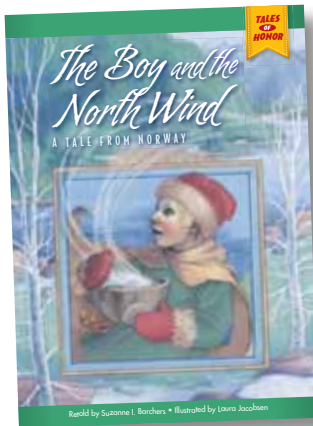
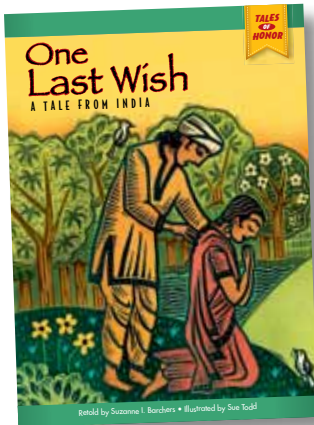

When the wind blows away the flour in the bowl being prepared by the young baker's assistant, he sets out on a journey to insist that it be returned.

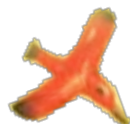

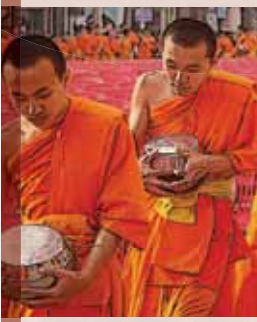

In 1941, President Franklin Roosevelt gave a speech to Congress in which he outlined four universal freedoms he felt all people in the world should enjoy. America was still emerging from the Great Depression. Europe was at war. Our closest ally Great Britain was in grave danger. But Americans were hesitant to support the war efforts. When the U.S. eventually entered WWII, these Four Freedoms represented America's goals and gave hope to its war-weary people that they were fighting for freedom everywhere.

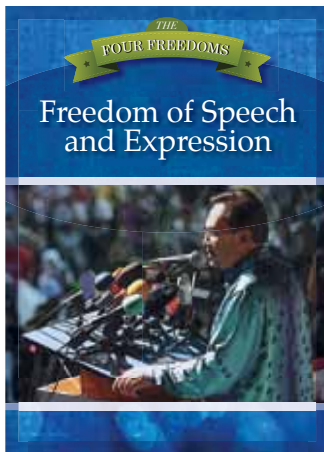

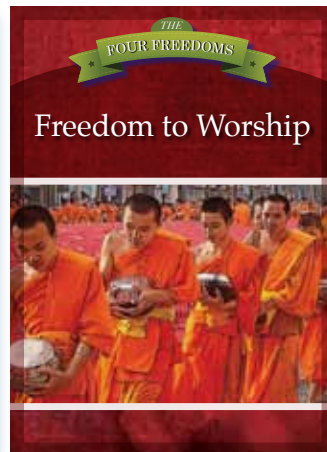

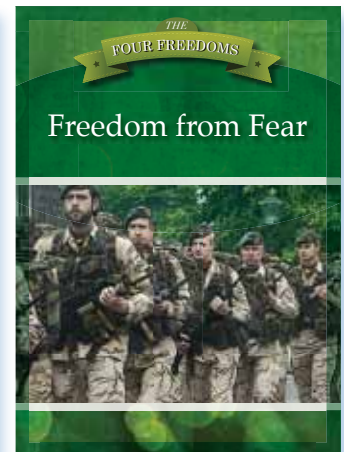
