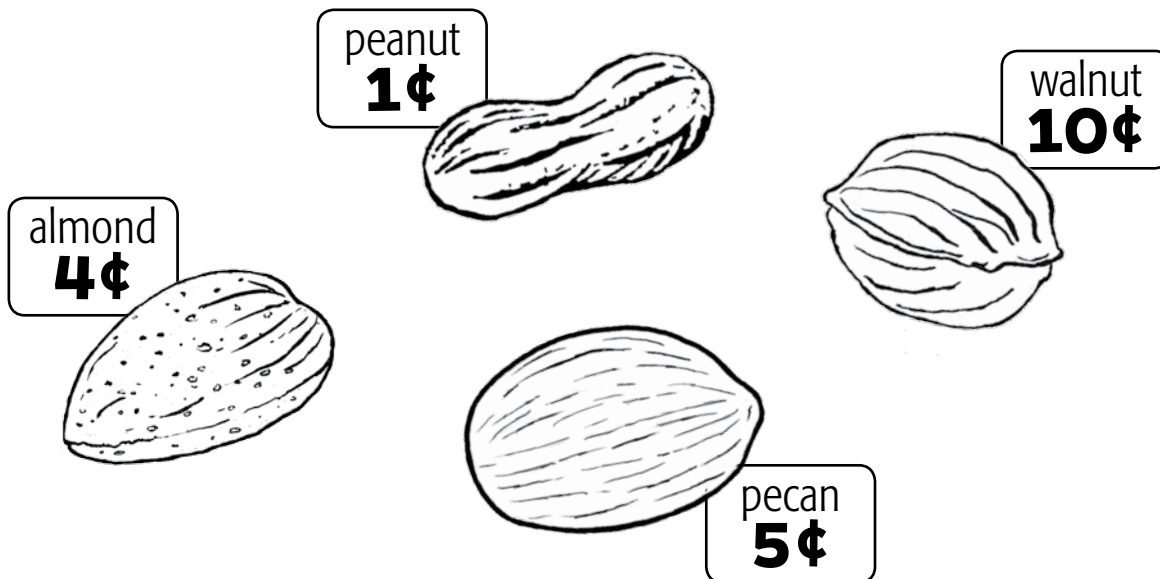

Go shopping for nuts! How many of each type of nut could you buy if you have 20 cents? How many walnuts could you buy? How many almonds could you buy?

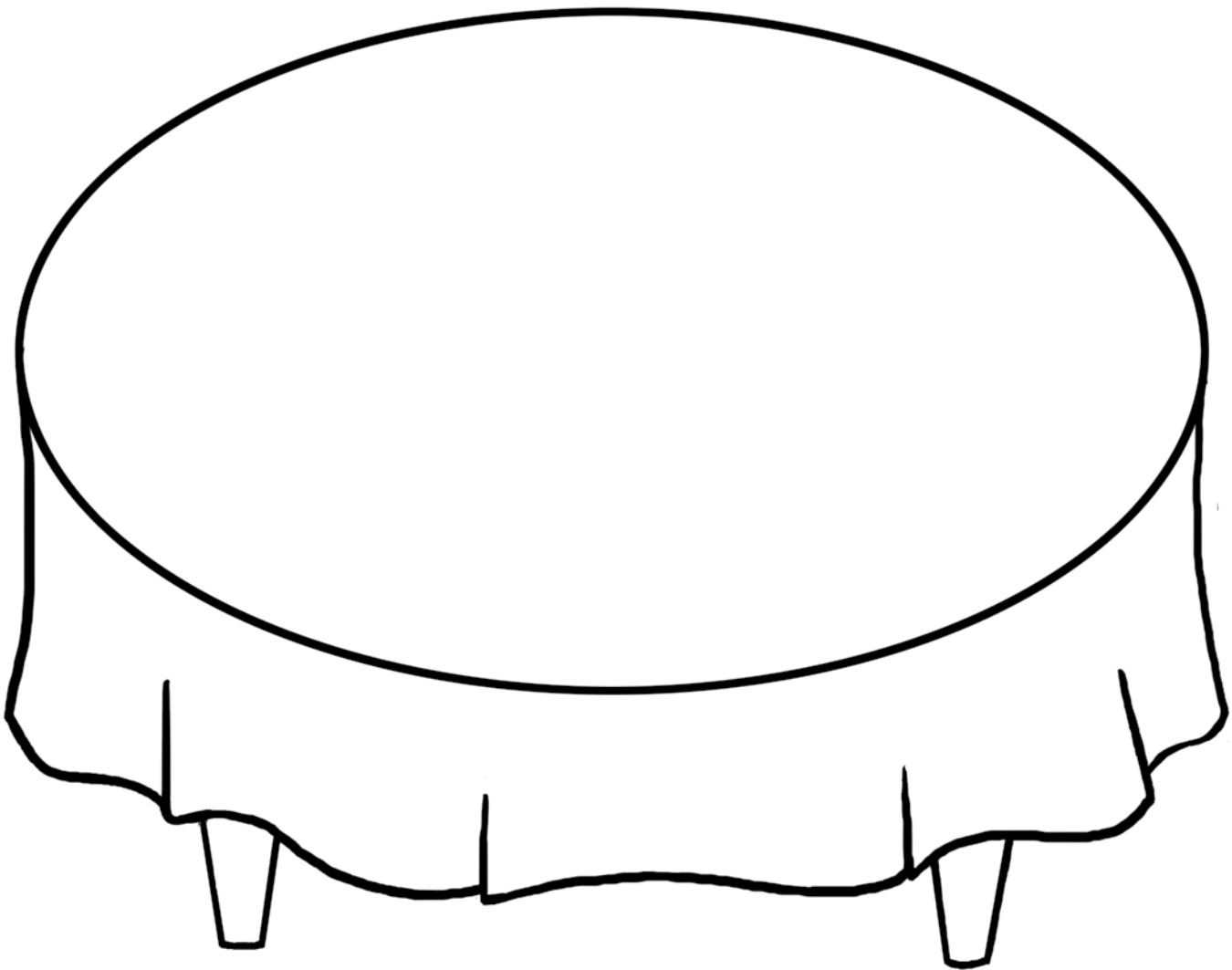

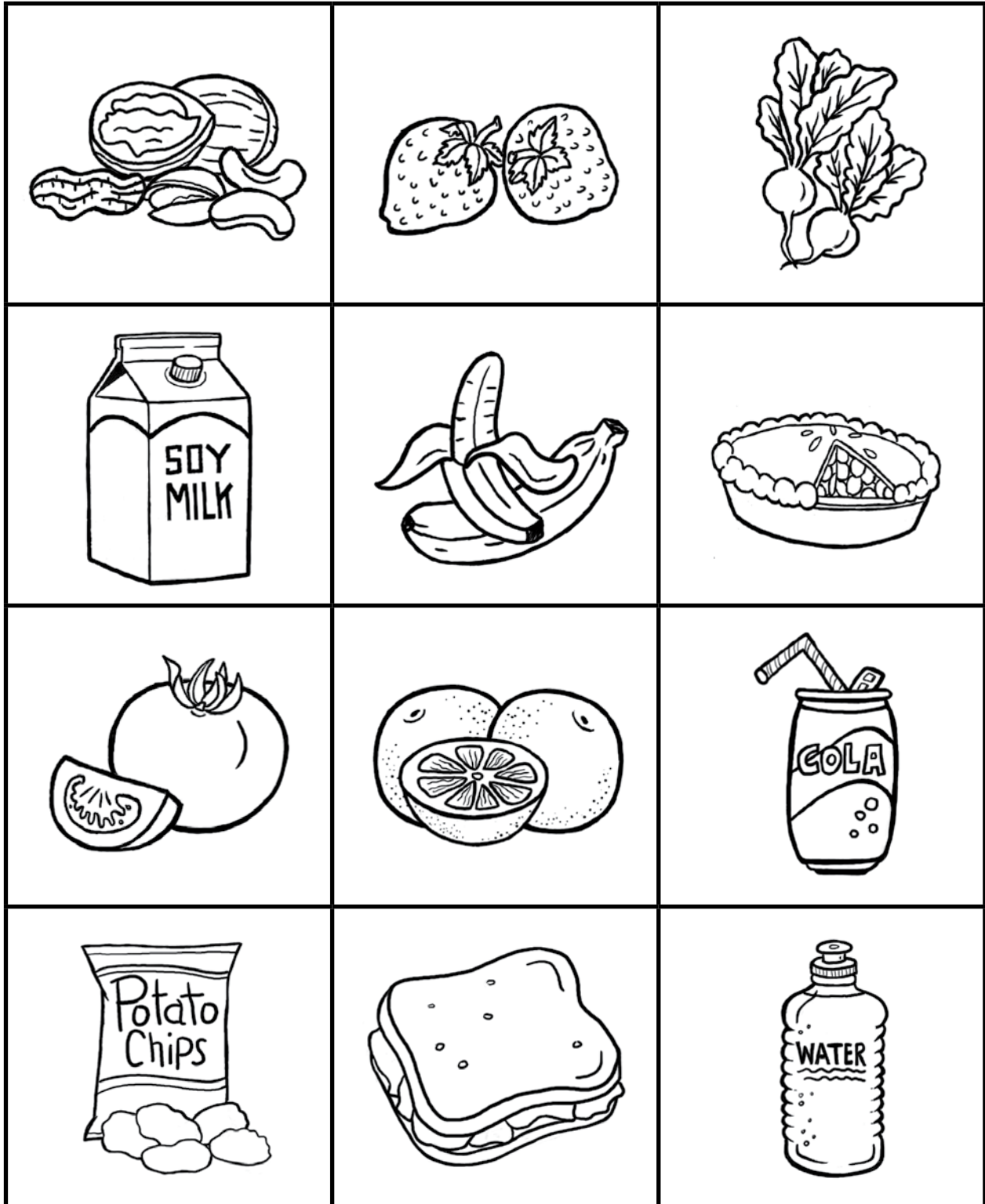
My Picnic Lunch
