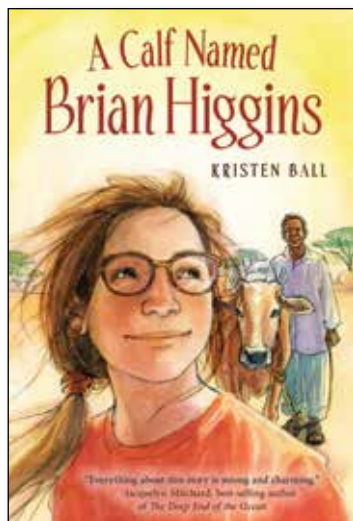
# A Calf Named Brian Higgins
